**SAUL EWING ASSOCIATE NAMED “DAUPHIN COUNTY *PRO BONO*
COUNSEL OF THE YEAR”**

(Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, November 10, 2008) – Amy C. Foerster, a Litigation Associate in Saul Ewing’s Harrisburg office, has been named “Dauphin County *Pro Bono* Counsel of the Year” by the Dauphin County Bar Association.
